CONSIDERATIONS AND REQUESTS

A. Easterwood Benefit Charge Appeal

Carlene Easterwood submitted an appeal to the District dated March 1, 2021, requesting the benefit charge on her mobile home park be reduced to what she considers a fairer amount. The District's Benefit Charge Appeal Committee met on March 2nd to review her request. The committee took into consideration the type of structures on the property (8 individual carports), the value of improvements (\$7,400),

and that she has been granted a reduction by the Board each of the last nine years. The committee also took into consideration that individual mobile homeowners pay a benefit charge. The Appeal Committee recommends honoring her request to reduce the benefit charge from a commercial rate to a residential rate.

Commissioner Stringfellow moved and Commissioner Eckroth seconded to approve reducing the 2021 benefit charge on parcel no. 0420226009 from a commercial rate of \$1,332.60 to a residential rate of \$335.05. **MOTION CARRIED.**

Ms. Easterwood further asked if the District would consider automatically recalculating the benefit charge to the residential rate as long as there is no change in the property's use, square footage of structures, or significant change in the assessed valuation. The Appeal Committee recommends the District deny her request at this time and address this on a more global level in the upcoming resolution establishing updated benefit charge policy and procedure.

Commissioner Stringfellow moved and Commissioner Willis seconded to deny Ms. Easterwood's request to automatically reduce the benefit charge on parcel no. 0420226009 to residential, and address this type of situation in the upcoming resolution establishing updated benefit charge policy and procedure. **MOTION CARRIED.**

SUMMARY:

In preparation of future federal audits of the Ground Emergency Medical Transportation (GEMT) revenue and spending program, CPFR wishes to hire Moss to accomplish the following:

- 1. Review GEMT cost reporting allocations and methodologies to be sure they are well documented, repeatable, and compliant with GEMT guidelines.
- 2. Service provided is estimated at \$11k \$13k plus billed expenses (travel etc).
- 3. If funding approved here is sufficient would also like Moss to assist in development of procedures for reporting and spending.

Moss when complete will issue a final report, which will be shared with the Board.

 - i. to your professional advisors (acting strictly in an advisory capacity and who are subject to these disclosure restrictions), who may review it only to give you advice relating to the Services;
 - ii. to the extent, and for the purposes, required by subpoena or similar legal process (of which you will promptly notify us);

- iii. to the extent, and for the purposes, required by regulatory or self-regulatory authorities in connection with routine audits and examinations as long as Moss Adams, a Report and the Services are not the subject of the audit or examination;
- iv. with our prior written consent, to third parties who have executed an access letter in the form we prescribe;
- v. as expressly stated in an SOW; or
- vi. to the extent it contains Tax Advice, as set forth below.
- c. Our Reports may include spreadsheets, models, or other software tools. Such items are provided solely for your convenience in "as is" condition without warranty of any kind. We assume no responsibility for results obtained by anyone other than Moss Adams from the use of such items.
- d. You acknowledge that Moss Adams has not placed any limitations on your disclosure of the tax returns, tax treatment or tax structure associated with any tax services under this Agreement ("Tax Advice"), and nothing in this Agreement shall be construed as limiting or restricting your disclosure of Tax Advice. Our charges may include any applicable sales and gross receipts tax, and direct and indirect expenses based on out-of-pocket expenditures, per diem allotments, mileage reimbursements, processing charges and technology expenses. Billings are due upon presentation and become delinquent if not paid within 30 days of the invoice date. Any past due fee under this Agreement shall bear interest at the lower of twelve percent (12%) per annum or the highest rate allowed by law on any unpaid balance.
- b. If we are required by applicable law, legal process, or government action to produce information or personnel as witnesses with respect to the Services or this Agreement, you shall reimburse us for any professional time and expenses (including reasonable external and internal legal costs) incurred to respond to the request, unless we are a party to the proceeding or the subject of the investigation.

5. Limitations

a. THE TOTAL LIABILITY OF MOSS ADAMS, ITS OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, PARTNERS, PRINCIPALS, MEMBERS, EMPLOYEES, SUBCONTRACTORS, AND AGENTS (COLLECTIVELY, "MOSS ADAMS PERSONS") TO YOU OR ANY THIRD PARTY FOR ANY AND ALL DAMAGES WHATSOEVER ARISING OUT OF THIS AGREEMENT FROM ANY CAUSE, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO NEGLIGENCE, ERRORS, OMISSIONS, STRICT LIABILITY, BREACH OF CONTRACT, OR BREACH OF WARRANTY SHALL NOT, IN THE AGGREGATE, EXCEED THE FEES PAID OR PAYABLE TO MOSS ADAMS UNDER THIS AGREEMENT DURING THE TWELVE (12) MONTHS PRIOR TO THE ACT OR OMISSION THAT CAUSED THE LOSS. THIS LIMITATION WILL NOT APPLY TO THE EXTENT LOSSES ARE CAUSED BY OUR FRAUD OR WILLFUL MISCONDUCT.

- b. IN NO EVENT WILL EITHER PARTY BE LIABLE TO THE OTHER FOR ANY SPECIAL, INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL, EXEMPLARY, PUNITIVE OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES IN CONNECTION WITH OR OTHERWISE ARISING OUT OF THIS AGREEMENT EVEN IF ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES.
- c. You shall make any claim relating to the Services or otherwise under this Agreement no later than one (1) year after you became aware (or should reasonably have become aware) of the facts giving rise to such claim and in any event, no later than two (2) years after the completion of the particular Services. This limitation will not apply to the extent prohibited by applicable law, regulations or professional regulations.

- b. Either of us may use electronic media to correspond or transmit information and such use will not in itself constitute a breach of any confidentiality obligations under this Agreement.
- c. Unless prohibited by applicable law, we use Client Information, and provide it to Moss Adams Persons, to facilitate or improve performance of the Services, to comply with regulatory requirements, and for quality and risk management purposes. We also utilize service providers, such as cloud-based software vendors, to support our operations and enable us to provide our Services to you ("Service Providers"). 10. Subpoena of Documents

We will notify you of any such request and you may, within the time permitted for us to respond to any request, initiate such legal action as you deem appropriate to protect information from discovery. If you take no action within the time permitted for us to respond or if your action does not result in a judicial order protecting us from supplying requested information, we will produce information to the extent required by law.

11. Use of a Party's Name

No Party may use another Party's name, its trademarks, service marks or logos in connection with the Services or otherwise without the prior written consent of such Party, which consent may be withheld for any reason and may be subject to certain conditions, although we may publicly identify you as a client in connection with specific Services or generally.

12. Force Majeure

No Party shall be liable for breach of this Agreement (other than payment obligations) caused by circumstances beyond such Party's reasonable control.

13. Governing Law and Dispute Resolution

- a. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the state of Washington, without giving effect to any conflicts of laws principles.
- b. If a dispute arises out of or relates to this Agreement, and if the dispute cannot be settled through negotiations, the Parties agree first to try in good faith to settle the dispute by mediation using an agreed upon mediator. Each Party shall be responsible for its own mediation expenses, and shall share equally in the mediator's fees and expenses.
- c. If the claim or dispute cannot be settled through mediation, each Party hereby irrevocably (a) consents to the exclusive jurisdiction and venue of the appropriate state or federal court located in King County, state of Washington, in connection with any dispute hereunder or the enforcement of any right or obligation hereunder, and (b) WAIVES ITS RIGHT TO A JURY TRIAL.

14. Term and Termination

- a. This Agreement shall remain in effect until terminated as provided below.
- b. This Agreement and any SOW may be terminated by either Party, with or without cause, upon ten (10) days written notice. In the event of such notice, we will stop providing Services except on work, mutually agreed upon in writing, necessary to carry out such termination. Termination of this Agreement shall automatically terminate all SOWs in progress, however, termination of a particular SOW shall not affect the validity of this Agreement or any other SOWs.
- c. In the event of termination, (i) you shall pay us for Services provided and expenses incurred through the effective date of termination, (ii) we will provide you with all finished Reports, and (iii) neither Party shall be liable to the other for any damages that occur as a result of our ceasing to render Services.
- d. The provisions of this Agreement that give either of us rights or obligations beyond its termination shall continue indefinitely following the termination of this Agreement.

15. General Terms

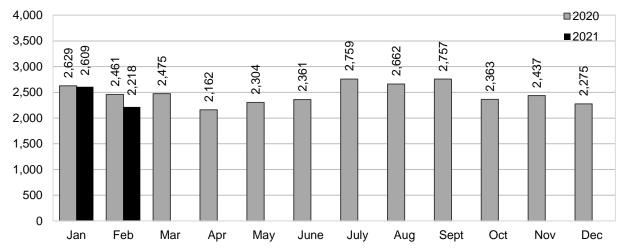

Month-to-Month Comparison

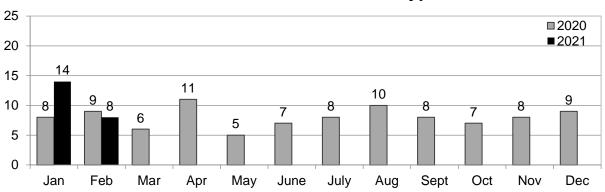

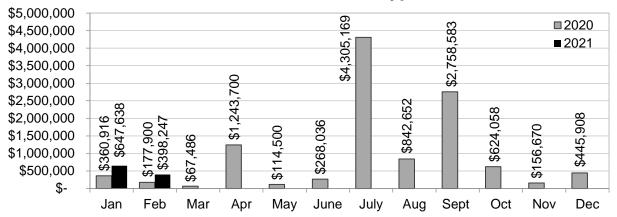

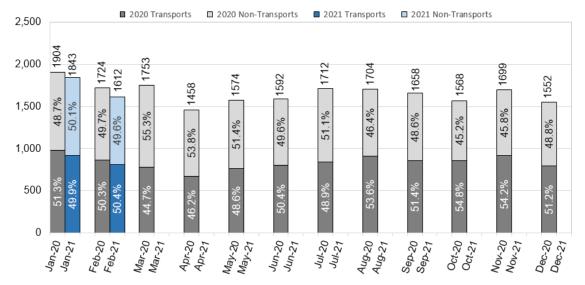
Structure Fires – 111 Call Type

Board of Fire Commissioners:

- 1. **Vacation:** I wanted to thank the BOC for allowing me to take a spring vacation this year. I got back to work on Wednesday and am getting caught up on the many items we have moving.
- 2. **Armory Property:** We met with the Armory and got to walk through the buildings and property in order to have the correct image and feel of the asset. We walked away pleased and found out that a small parcel next to it may also be available. The property overall is in a good location, buildable, and a great long term center for Station 73.
- 3. **Washington Fire Chiefs Legislative Committee:** I have been virtually attending these meetings and will update the BOC on the status of legislation once we are passed the bill drop off date.
- 4. **Benefit Charge:** We had an update meeting with the Quinns regarding the modernization of our BC. We are now final editing the proposed resolution and contract with our consultant. Once we know the final direction of the resolution, we will finalize the associated policy and procedure. Additionally, we will be recommending a date and type of FBC election for your consideration.

Dianne has been busy attending to the error in the number and type of exempt properties allowed. We are working with Pierce County to correct the tax statements.



We are including a narrative with the revised tax statements explaining the problem and solution. This could be sent out as early as the last week of March.

- 5. **BC Promotional Interviews:** I am completing interviews with all of the BC candidates. It has been a pleasure to listen to these future leaders, their passion, vision, and desire to be good leaders. CPF&R's future stands with these leaders and it is in good hands.
- 6. **Ribbon Cutting Crisis Recovery Center:** The facility is completed and should be operational over the next few weeks. I was allowed to say a few words at the ceremony and reflected appreciation to the County Executive for listening to CPF&R regarding the location and the value the services will provide our collective citizens.
- 7. IT Consortium: We have met again with our consortium partners and Attorney Brian Snure. We have reviewed the draft document and fee structures. We received some constructive feedback and are adjusting the document to reflect the consensus of the group. During the meeting I realized the need to be closely connected to the IT director as he takes on this new and ground breaking role within the Pierce County Fire Service. As a result, I am assuming the role of supervisor for the IT director in order to assure clarity of direction and clean communication. I will do this until the consortium question is resolved.

8. **COVID-19**:

- a. Emergency Declaration- No changes from previous meeting. The authority has not been exercised during the previous two-week period. I will continue to report any uses of the declarations authority.
- b. Governor Proclamation: The Governor is moving all of Washington into Phase 3. We do not know how this will impact our public meetings. Right now there is no mandate to return to face to face open public meetings. I spoke with Attorney Quinn who advised preparing now for a transition to a hybrid model where the BOC as individuals can decide when they will want to attend open public meetings.
