#### BEEP, BEEP, BEEP

"Three beeps in a row means it's time to go!"

Three beeps tells you there is smoke in your home. This means it is no longer safe to stay inside, so it's time to leave and go outside!

#### CHIRP. CHIRP.

"One chirp tells me: the smoke alarm needs new batteries!"

Smoke alarms need batteries, and when it's time for new ones, they will chirp for everyone to hear. Adults in your home should be the one to change those batteries!

### THE BIG FOUR

Follow these four easy steps if you hear the three beeps of the smoke alarm!

- 1. STOP WHAT YOU ARE DOING.
- 2. CHOOSE THE BEST WAY OUT OF THE ROOM.
- 3. GET OUTSIDE QUICKLY (AND STAY OUTSIDE).
- 4. GO TO YOUR OUTSIDE MEETING PLACE.
