## Find Someone Who

### Instructions:

Each student takes their "Find Someone Who" sheet and goes on a scavenger type hunt. Teachers read aloud the words in each square, and then have the students quietly walk around the classroom to find someone who matches each description. When a student finds a peer who can say yes to the statement, that child signs his or her name. Students can only sign one another's scavenger hunt sheet once.
