

Central Pierce Fire & Rescue, Graham Fire & Rescue, and Orting Valley Fire & Rescue are asking voters to create a new, unified regional fire service organization. Potential benefits include:

- Improved response times and coordination during emergencies.
- More flexibility to allocate resources based on real-time needs, allowing for better service in all areas of the district.
- Streamlined resources minimize duplication and provide cost savings.
- Strengthened ability to adapt to future growth and service needs.
- No job losses, and no station closures.
- No new funding requests, such as levy increases or bonds. Fire Benefit Charge (FBC) formulas will be standardized for consistency, with any adjustments not intended to generate additional revenue.

If merged, the three fire districts would become one unified fire district with a new identity and organizational culture. Voters in the Graham Fire & Rescue and Orting Valley Fire & Rescue areas will decide on this measure on April 22, 2025.
