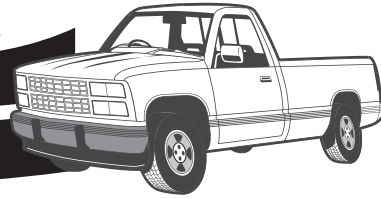
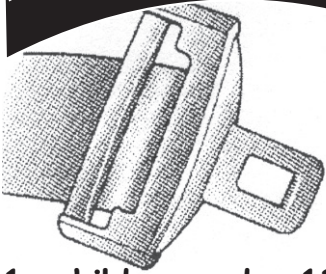


Key(front):

3. You should never share a safety belt with another person because everyone in the vehicle needs their own safety belt.
4. Always obey the driver's safety rules when riding on the bus.
5. When waiting for the bus, always stay far back from the road until the bus has come to a complete stop.
