


—like a seat cushion




# Safety Reminder

When near shore or on a boat, wear your life jacket. Just like Bobby, you never know when you will need your life jacket.




#### Parent Note


The best thing anyone can do to stay safe in and around the water is to learn to swim. However, nothing replaces proper adult supervision when children are around water.









